Like many businesses, our journey has come with its share of challenges. We launched our first scheduled tour in 2020, but unfortunately had no customers. In 2021, operations were put on hold due to the COVID-19 pandemic. In 2022, our one-week tour was nearly sold out before the MLB lockout led to widespread customer cancellations. Despite the setback, we adjusted our itinerary and successfully operated a modified five-day sightseeing tour for eight guests.

Since then, Arizona Baseball Tours has experienced steady growth. In 2023, we welcomed 54 guests across two successful tours. The following year, we expanded to three tours and hosted 101 guests. Growth continued in 2025 with 141 guests, and in 2026, we reached a new milestone, serving 173 guests.

Today, Arizona Baseball Tours specializes in fully planned spring training vacations that combine great baseball, quality accommodations, local attractions, and personalized service. While our company has grown, our commitment remains the same: providing memorable experiences and bringing baseball fans together through a shared love of the game.

We are proud of how far we've come and excited about the future as we continue helping fans create their own spring training memories.

We always try to get physical paper tickets for all games and attractions for tour participants. However, many venues are transitioning from paper tickets to digital ticketing. We recommend installing the MLB Ballpark app on your smartphone in case we are unable to obtain paper tickets for games. If you have the Ballpark app, we can send the digital game tickets to you. If you don't have the Ballpark app, we can scan you in at the gate.

Important Update Regarding Our 2027 Tour

The current MLB collective bargaining agreement between the owners and players expires December 1, 2026. If there is a lockout and a new agreement is not reached by January 14, 2027 (the deadline for us to release our group room block back to the hotel without penalty), the tour will be canceled, and all deposits will be fully refunded.

Reservations

A \$100 deposit per person is required at booking to secure your reservation.

2027 Cancellation Policy

You can cancel for a full refund at any time through January 14, 2027. If the MLB lockout remains in effect as of that date, we will cancel the tour and issue full refunds to all participants. If the tour is confirmed to proceed as planned, cancellations made after January 14, 2027 will be non-refundable.

Final Payment

If the tour proceeds as planned, your remaining balance is due January 21, 2027
